French Language and Civilization Course at the University of Paris IV, La Sorbonne

Elementary French I & II - Level(s) 100

This course consists of three components – French civilization, language and phonetics. The course is designed to give a good basic foundation in French covering vocabulary, grammar, phonetics, reading, conversation and laboratory work. The course is suitable for absolute beginners or for students with some high school French. French civilization coursework covers a range of topics including literature, art, music, history, economics and social questions of the day.

The language & civilization components meet for an average of 22 hours per week. The phonetics component meets for an average of 3 hours per week. Transcripts total 150 contact hours. Instruction is in French.

Intermediate French - Level(s) 200

This course consists of three components – French civilization, language and phonetics. The course reinforces basic grammar as well as the more advanced aspects of the French language including vocabulary, phonetics, reading, conversation and laboratory work. Emphasis is placed on written composition and small group oral work. French civilization coursework covers a range of topics including literature, art, music, history, economics and social questions of the day.

The language & civilization components meet for an average of 22 hours per week. The phonetics component meets for an average of 3 hours per week. Transcripts total 150 contact hours. Instruction is in French.
